Gentlemen:

Magnolia Petroleum Company's Application for Administrative Approval of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit and an Exception to Well Location for the #2 State "C" Located with the Jalmat Gas Pool of Lea County, New Mexico.

Magnolia Petroleum Company herein makes application for the administrative approval for a non-standard gas proration unit and an exception to the location of the producing well of that unit. The proposed unit is located within the confines of the Jalmat Gas Pool and may be described as:

Approval of an unorthodox well location is sought under Rule 3 of Commission Order No. R-520. In conformance with Rule 3 the applicant attests to the following:

- 1. The well location is occasioned by the recompletion of the well previously drilled to another horizon.
- 2. All operators within a 1980 foot radius of the well have been furnished a copy of this application and have been requested by letter to make any objection to the well location

known to the Commission within 20 days. Copies of these letters, sent by registered mail, are attached and meant to be a part of this application.

Permission by administrative approval for a non-standard proration unit is sought under the provisions of Rule 5(b) of Order R-520. The applicant attests to the following in compliance with Rule 5(b):

- 1. The proposed unit consists of contiguous quarterquarter sections.
- 2. The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The proposed unit reasonably appears to be productive of gas in its entirety.
- 4. Neither the length nor the width of the proposed will exceed 5280 feet.
- 5. In lieu of paragraph (5) of Rule 5(b), all operators owning interests in Section 16 and whose acreage is not a part of the proposed unit, and all other operators owning interests within 1500 feet of the producing well have been notified by registered mail of the applicant's intent to form this unit. They have been furnished copies of this application and requested to make any objection known to the Commission within 20 days. Copies of these letters are attached and meant to be a part of this application.

Certified acreage plats are attached which set out the well location and the proposed attributable acreage and are also, meant to be a part of this application.

Magnolia Petroleum Company having established that the facts set out above fully comply with requirements of Rules 3 and 5(b) of Order R-520 respectfully request the Commission, by administrative approval, grant permission for a non-standard proration unit

and for an exception to the location for the producing well of that unit.

Magnolia Petroleum Company's Application for a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit and for an Exception to the Location of the Producing Well of that Unit, in the Jalmat Gas Pool of Lea County, New Mexico.

Attached you will find Magnolia's application for a non-standard proration unit and an exception to the well location. The unit will be comprised of the SE/4 SW/4 and the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 16-T23S-R36E of Lea County, New Mexico. The producing well of that unit would be the Magnolia #2 State "C", which is located 330 FSL and 1650 FEL of Section 16. This well has recently been recompleted in Jalmat (Yates) Gas Pool. Please examine this application and if objections to it are found, so notify the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission within 20 days. Rules 3 and 5(b) of Commission Order R-520 governing the Jalmat Gas Pool require that you as operator of leases within 1980 feet of the producing well

or in the same section as the proposed unit be notified of Magnolia's intention to form this unit.
