PESCO repairs oil and gas production and processing equipment such as tanks, dehydrators, and pressure vessels at this facility. Approximately 1 gallon of solvent, 1 gallon of xylene, 5 gallons of glycol, 850 gallons wash water, 2 drums of inert solids and paraffin, 1/4 yd<sup>3</sup> metal of blast media and grindings, 1/2 tons of scrap metal and 6 yd<sup>3</sup> of paper, cardboard and general office waste are generated on site monthly, which are collected and temporarily stored in containment vessels prior to transport and disposal at an NMOCD approved facilities. Groundwater most likely to be affected by a spill, leak or accidental discharge is at a depth of approximately 2353 feet, with a total dissolved solids concentration of approximately 1840 mg/l. The discharge plan addresses how oilfield products and waste will be properly handled, stored, and disposed of, including how spills, leaks, and other accidental discharges to the surface will be managed in order to protect fresh water. 

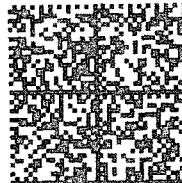
