This is Shell Oil Company's application for a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit to be dedicated to Shell Taylor Glenn No. 1, Blinebry (gas) Field, Lea County, New Mexico. As shown on the attached plat, this well is located 1980 feet from west line and 3226 feet from north line of Section 3, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Shell Taylor-Glenn No. 1 was completed as a Blinebry (Gas) producer in August 1956. Currently, 80 acres comprising Lots 6 and 11 (outlined in red on the attached plat) are dedicated to this well. We are requesting a reduction in unit size because of the recent completion of Taylor-Glenn No. 9, located in Lot 6, as a Blinebry (Oil) producer.
