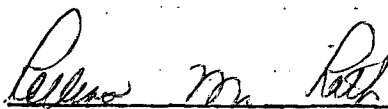
Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under provisions of Rule 5 (c) of Order No. 1670 for the formation of an 40 acre non-standard gas proration unit for its Sarkey, Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the west line and its Sarkey, Well No. 2 located 660 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the west line, Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico in the Blinebry Gas Pool. These two wells were reclassified by order of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission effective January 1, 1963 from Blinebry Oil wells to Blinebry gas wells. In support of this request we state the following:

1. The proposed non-standard 40 acre unit for Well No. 1 consists of the SW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 37 East and the proposed non-standard 40 acre unit for Well No. 2 consists of NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 37 East.
2. Each unit lies wholly within a single governmental quarter section.

3. The entire non-standard unit for each well may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of either unit does not exceed 2640 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been submitted to all operators as required under Rule 5 (c) subparagraph 6.

In view of these facts, it is requested that the Commission enter an order approving the non-standard gas proration unit for Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company, Sarkey Well No. 1 and Sarkey Well No. 2, as described above.

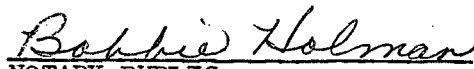

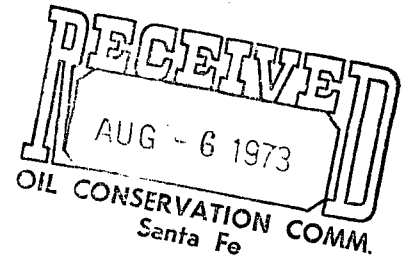

Dear Sir:

The subject well will be reclassified to a gas well September 1, 1973. In order to comply with provisions of Order No. R-1670 pertaining to the Blinebry gas pool, the Texas Pacific Oil Co., Inc. requests that a 40 acre non-standard proration unit be assigned this well located 1980' FNL & 660' FWL of Sec. 25. This 40 acres being the SW/4 of the NW/4 of Sec. 25, T-21-S; R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

On May 23, 1963 this well was assigned administrative Order NSP-644 to produce this 40 acres as a Blinebry gas well. In June 1968 it was re-completed to Blinebry oil. We request your authority to grant us a NSP unit of 40 acre allowable in accordance with the pool rules.

All offset operators have been notified by a copy of this request.

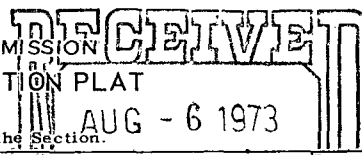

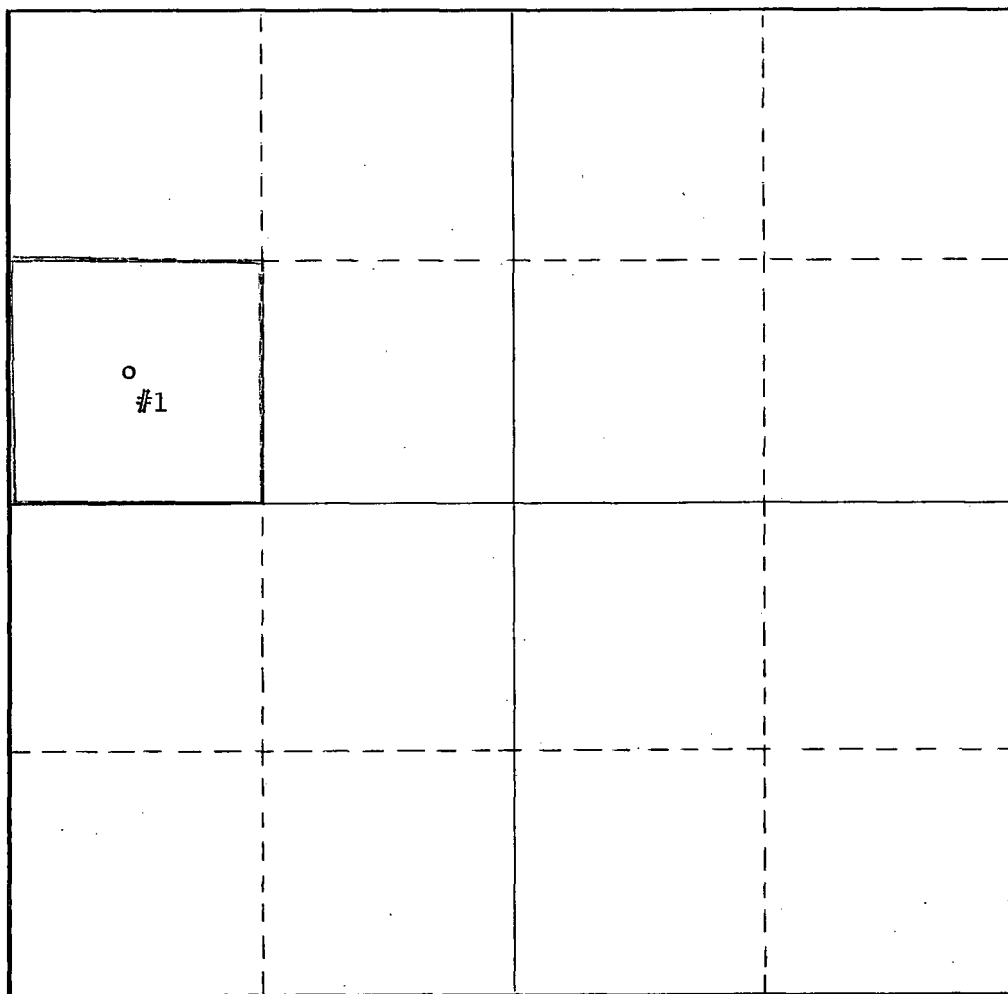
