Gentlemen:

Please consider this the application of Shell Oil Company for a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit to be dedicated to Shell Turner No. 12, Blinebry (Gas) Field, Lea County, New Mexico. As seen on the attached plot, this well is located 2065' FSL and 1700' FWL of Section 22, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Shell Turner 12 was completed as a Drinkard (oil) producer in June 1950, and dual completed as a Drinkard (oil) and Blinebry (oil) producer in August 1963. The Blinebry (oil) production will be reclassified as a Blinebry (gas) well, effective August 1, 1964, on the basis of a recently submitted gas-oil ratio report which showed the well to be producing gas in excess of 32,000 cubic feet per barrel. The outline of the proposed unit is shown in red on the attached plot.
