ASSISTANT DISTRICT MANAGER

We forward herewith application in triplicate for approval of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit for our Hawk B-l No. l well located in Section 9, T-21S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This Blinebry gas well produces for the Hawk B-l Unit which is a communitization of "A" and "B" federal leases. The recent recompletion of our Hawk B-l No. 3 necessitated the subtraction of the 40-acre tract dedicated to that well for Blinebry oil allowable from the Blinebry gas unit. In order to maintain the proportion of "A" and "B" acreage contemplated by the communitization agreement it is necessary to reduce the unit to 80-acres in size.

It is our present plan to continue development of the acreage in this unit for Blinebry oil. It is probable that the Blinebry gas unit will be completely eliminated in the near future.

Your further handling and approval of this application will be sincerely appreciated.

Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry Gas Pool of Order No. R-1670 for the formation of an 80-acre nonstandard gas provation unit consisting of S/2 NW/4 Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, for 1ts Hawk B-1 No. 1 well located 1,980 feet from the north line and 1,980 feet from the west line of Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Blinebry Gas Pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5(b) in all respects as follows:

- 1. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- 2. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental quarter-section.
- 3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- 4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 2,640 feet.
- 5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mall to all operators in the same quarter-section and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said Rule 5(b).


