Gentlemen:

Tenneco Oil Company proposes to drill a 12,350 foot Ellenburger test well at a location in the approximate center of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE/4 NW/4) of Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Because of the unorthodox size of the tract, Tenneco Oil Company proposes to allocate to such well a non-standard spacing unit comprising Lots 1, 2, 4 and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE/4 NW/4) of said Section 4, containing 93.8 acres.

Enclosed are three (3) plats showing the location of the proposed well and unit area.

Pursuant to Rule 3 of the Temporary Operating Rules and Regulations for the Stateline-Ellenburger Pool, Tenneco Oil Company does hereby request administrative approval of an exception to Rule 2 of the captioned Pool Rules for a non-standard unit comprising Lots 1, 2, 4 and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE/4 NW/4) of Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, for the drilling of a 12,350 foot Ellenburger test well in the approximate center of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE/4 NW/4) of said Section 4.




