Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval of a 138-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit for the Seven Rivers Hills Unit Well No. 4, located 600 feet from the north line and 830 feet from the east line of Section 4, T-21S, R-25E, Seven Rivers Hills Morrow Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. This Non-Standard Unit will comprise Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8 of Section 4 and is necessitated by a variation in the legal subdivision of the U. S. Public Land Survey.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- (1) The Seven Rivers Hills Morrow Gas Pool was established by Order R-2569 dated October 1, 1963; therefore, the Standard Unit for this pool is 160 acres.
- (2) It is not possible to form a standard 160-acre unit substantially in the form of a square, being a quarter section, due to the variation in the legal subdivisions of this Section 4.
- (3) Applicant proposes to dedicate Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8 as a Non-Standard Proration Unit containing 138 acres, more or less, substantially in the form of a square as shown on the attached plat.
- (4) Applicant operates all acreage in the proposed Non-Standard Unit.

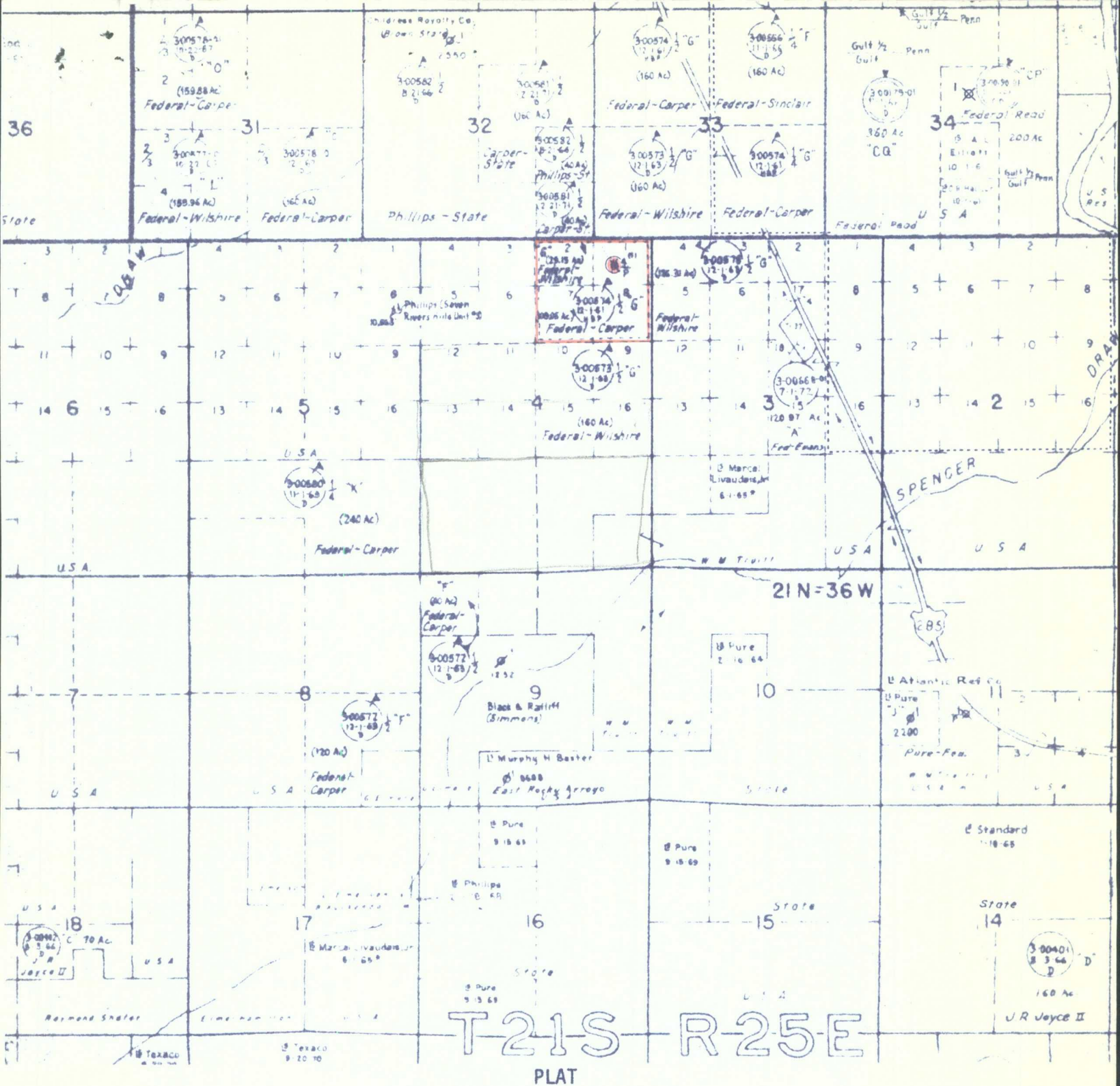


