#### Gentlemen:

Forwarded herewith in triplicate is our application for administrative approval of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit for the State KT Well No. 1 located in Unit J-24-21S-35E, Lea County, New Mexico.

This well was formerly an oil well but was reclassified to a gas well as of September 1, 1969. We propose to allocate the 40-acre tract upon which the well is located for gas proration purposes, as well as the adjoining 40-acre tract upon which is located our well No. 2. Well No. 2 was shut in in 1964 due to non-commercial rates. On its last test, it produced no oil or water and a small quantity of gas.

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool of Order No. R-1670 for the formation of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of W/2 SE/4 Section 24, T-21S, R-35E, for its State KT-24 Well No. 1, located 2310 feet from the south line and 1800 feet from the east line of Section 24, T-21S, R-35E, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool.

In support of this request, we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5(c) in all respects as follows:

- Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- 4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- A copy of this application has been sent to all offset operators and all operators in the same section.

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 1 well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.


The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.
