Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval of an 80-acre nonstandard Blinebry Gas proration unit, covering the E/2 SE/4 Section 30, T-22-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This nonstandard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's Drinkard (NCT-B) Well No. 1 located 660' FSL and 660' FEL of this Section 30.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- (1) Applicant's Drinkard (NCT-B) Well No. 1 is now assigned a 120-acre nonstandard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool, covering the E/2 SE/4 and SW/4 SE/4 of Section 30.
- (2) Applicant's Drinkard (NCT-B) Well No. 3 located in the SW/4 SE/4 of this Section 30 has been recompleted as a Blinebry Oil well.
- (3) The proposed 80-acre nonstandard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- (4) The nonstandard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (5) The entire nonstandard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
- (6) All operators owning interests outside the nonstandard gas proration unit but in the same section in which the nonstandard gas proration unit is situated have been furnished a copy of this application.

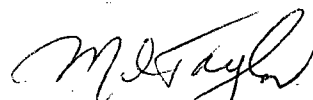

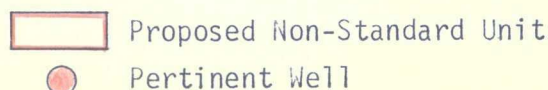
