Reference is made to your letter dated April 5, 1973, requesting approval of a non-standard proration unit of 80 acres to be dedicated to the Roger C. Hanks Brag Federal Well No. 1-Y located in Unit E of Section 28, Township 8 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico. Gentlemen:

In behalf of our client Roger C. Hanks, and in compliance with your Order 4486, entered March 2, 1973, we enclose herewith Form C-102 for a non-standard unit, comprising the S¹/₂NW¹/₄ Section 28, Township 8 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., to be dedicated to Mr. Hanks' Brag Federal Well 1-R (Now 1-Y), located 660 feet from the West line and 1830 feet from the North line of said Section 28 in the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool.
