The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received the Investigation and Characterization Plan Report and Corrective Action Proposal (CAP) for the above-referenced site, dated October 21 2009, and has conducted a review of the plan. The CAP substantially meets the requirements of 19.15.29 NMAC. Therefore, the OCD hereby conditionally approves the CAP:

ROC must implement the CAP within 60 days.

ROC must blend soils (if necessary) on the northern and eastern portions of the liner installation at the 5 feet to 12 feet bgs interval to a chloride concentration of no more than 300 mg/Kg.

Please be advised that OCD approval of this CAP does not relieve the owner/operator of responsibility should operations pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval does not relieve the owner/operator of responsibility for compliance with any OCD, federal, state, or local laws and/or regulations.
