

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Produced water was released into the area immediately next to the split flowline. A total of 100bbls of fluid was released. 80bbls of fluid was recovered by a vacuum truck. One-call protocol will be made by dirt contractor who will then wait for archeological/wildlife sensitivity clearance from BLM before removing any saturated soils prior to soil sampling by Tetra Tech (The closest well to the leak is the MCINTYRE DK FEDERAL #8 M-20-17S-30E 990 FSL 990 FWL 32 81558379 : 103 99955142) Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD/BLM for your approval prior to any significant remediation.

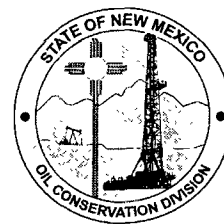

Standing water has been removed, in the process of digging out flow line to make repairs. Closest well to leak: DK McIntyre #8 Sec 17,T17S,R30E Eddy Co. I have NOT made notification to State or Fed, this is Fed. Will you contact them? Confirm you received this.
