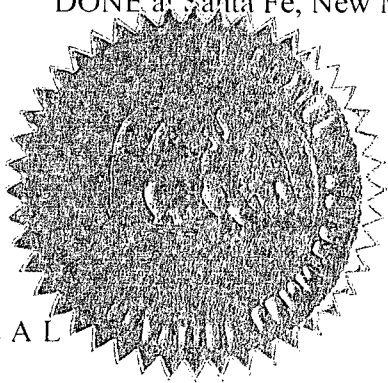
ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE
