

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Lightning struck the battery and caused a fire. A fiberglass water tank burned releasing produced water. All fluids stayed inside the plastic lined retaining wall. Vacuum trucks were used to recover the fluids.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

All fluids remained inside lined retaining wall. Impacted soil will be removed and disposed of at NMOCD -Approved facility. Soil was removed and backfilled with Geoff Leking of NMOCD approving the backfill and completion.
