Dear Mr. Compton:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated December 18, 2003 (*administrative application reference No. pLR0-336532092*), which was received by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe on December 30, 2003; and (ii) the Division's records in Santa Fe: all concerning GP II Energy, Inc.'s request for a non-standard 24.54-acre oil spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Undesignated Brushy Draw-Delaware Pool (8080):

EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO <u>TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, NMPM</u> Irregular Section 34: Lot 10.

This application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rule 104.D (2), revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999.

It is our understanding this unit is to be dedicated to GP II Energy Inc.'s proposed Littlefield "BO" Federal Well No. 6 to be drilled at a standard oil well location 423 feet from the South line and 2150 feet from the West line of irregular Section 34.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.D(2)(b), as revised, the abovedescribed 24.54-acre non-standard Delaware oil spacing and proration unit is hereby approved. Further, in accordance with Division Rule 104.G(1), as revised, GP II Energy, Inc. is permitted to produce the allowable assigned this 24.54-acre unit (0.614 acreage factor) from this well.
