Dear Mr. Veteto:

By Division Order No. R-453, dated May 27, 1954, a 160-acre non-standard Eumont Gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) comprising the W/2 W/2 of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, was authorized to be dedicated to the J.L. Barr Well No. 2 located 1985 feet from the South line and 661 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 24.

Subsequent to the issuance of said Order No. R-453, two additional wells were included in the subject GPU; the J.L. Barr Well Nos. 3 and 4 located at standard gas well locations in Units M and D, respectively, of said Section 24 (see Division Administrative Order SD-93-2).

Reference is now made to your application dated March 25, 1994 to reduce said 160-acre unit by deleting the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of said Section 24, which is to be utilized as a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Eumont Oil Pool for the J.L. Barr Well No. 4, which, as I understand, has been reclassified as an oil well in the Eumont Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described 120-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit is hereby approved.

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST
Section 24: SW/4 NW/4 and W/2 SW/4



Per your application dated August 9, 1993, Me-Tex Supply Company, as operator, is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas Pool production to the previously approved non-standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the W/2 W/2 of Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (Division Order No. R-453, dated May 27, 1954) from the two existing J.L. Barr Well Nos. 2 and 3 located at standard gas well locations in Units I and M, respectively, and to the proposed J.L. Barr Well No. 4 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D) of said Section 24.

Further you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject 160-acre unit from all three wells in any proportion.
