El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) (or SE/4 NW/4, NE/4 NW/4, Lots 1 and 2) of Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- The Pipkin #2 Well, located 1650' from the South line and 990' from the East line of Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, was completed as a gas well on April 30, 1951, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system December 20, 1951.
- That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 166.31 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
- That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
