Dear Mr. Arnold:

On March 30, 1955 Mr. C. H. Nieder wrote stating that the Oil Conservation Commission records indicated that our Brown #1, Hartman #1, Jensen #1, and Roberts #1 wells in the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool were Non-standard Gas Units. These wells actually are not Non-standard Units. The short acreage shown in the Gas Well Plats, as originally filed by our production superintendent, Mr. C. S. Short, were based on the addition of the acreage called for by our leases in the various quarter sections involved.

We are enclosing three copies of a corrected Gas Well Plat. A carbon copy of this letter is attached to each set of corrected plats.

Our leases cover all of the acreage within each quarter section. The discrepancies between the summation of the acreage called for in the leases are due to the fact that some tracts when surveyed for sale, possibly on a per acre basis, were surveyed only to boundary lines of the highway and the bank of the river.

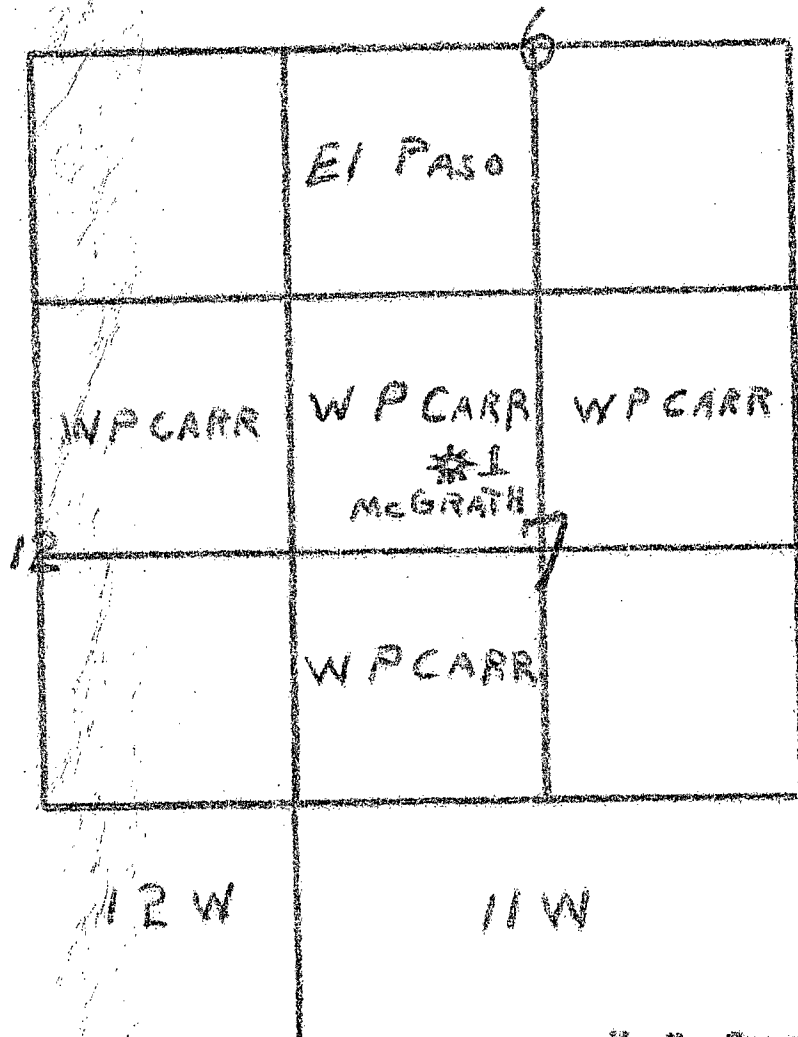
I trust that this letter will correct your records to show these four units as Standard Units.
