Gentlemen:

Pubco Petroleum Corporation, as Operator of the Pubco Suter-Federal No. 2-X Well, hereby submits Application for Approval of a Non-Standard Proration Unit, comprising the South Half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section 12, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. That the Pubco Suter-Federal No. 2-X Well is located 1750 feet from the South line and 1750 feet from the West line of Section 12, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 333.60 acres, which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots and which comprise the South Half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of said Section 12, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit are notified by Certified Mail, return receipt requested, of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.




