Gentlemen:

This is a request by Anderson-Prichard Oil Corporation for an exception to State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Order No. R-128-D, Rule No. 1, Paragraph A, under conditions set out in Rule No. 1, Paragraph B, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. That this non-standard gas production unit consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections or lots, it being the West half of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico;
2. That this non-standard gas production unit lies wholly in Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico;
3. That this non-standard gas production unit is believed to be productive of gas; and
4. That written consent in the form of waivers from all operators owning an interest in which this gas production unit lies, and all offset operators to the same unit, permitting us to produce gas from this non-standard production unit will be acknowledged and forwarded to your District Office in Aztec, New Mexico.





DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show diam, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

We will cut 150' to 175' of 10-3/4" casing and cement to surface. Full drill with bit to approximately 300' at which point we anticipate setting an intermediate string of 8-1/2" casing tubing. In this process we will drill with rotary equipment to 20' of approximately 600', or to a point 50' below the base of the first basement section of the New York formation. At this point 5-1/2" 13.3 lb 8-3/4" casing will be cut and with cement covering the whole of the New York formation. Low-Grade Cement Dry Surface log will then be run. Method of completion will be selective perforation and acid fract treatment of the first leakout, however, and the first three sections of the New York formation.

It is desired that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
