Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the West Half (W/2) (or Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, NE/4 NW/4, SE/4 NW/4, NE/4 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4) of Section 30, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Sellers #3-A Well, located 890 feet from the South line and 890 feet from the West line of Section 30, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, was dually completed as a gas well May 17, 1956, in the Mesaverde formation and the Pictured Cliffs formation.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 309.60 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.


