Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of All (Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, S/2 S/2) of Fractional Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Brown #1 Well, located 990' from the South line and 990' from the West line of Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, was completed as a gas well from the Mesaverde Formation on November 23, 1956.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 343.60 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That the entire fractional Section 9, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, is dedicated to this well and that all operators owning interests in acreage offsetting the non-standard proration unit are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.

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Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of Rule 1 (b) of Order No. R-128-C, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 1 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.

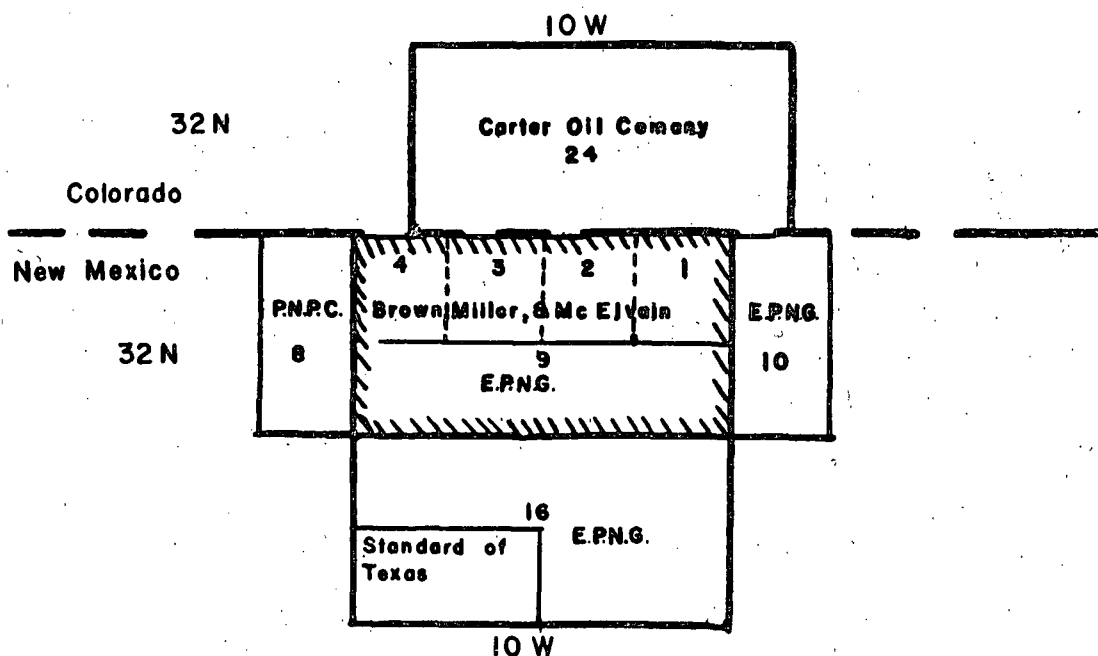
