Gentlemen:

In accordance with Order No. R-565-C, Rule 6 (B), request is made for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit for Northwest Production Corporation's "S" Well 5-2, which is located in the NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 2, Township 24 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The proposed non-standard unit for "S" Well 5-2 consists of the NW/4 of said Section 2, including lots 3 and 4 contiguous to the NW/4, a total of 223 acres. The unorthodox size of the proposed unit is caused by a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey, and it lies within a single governmental section, all of which is subject to an oil and gas lease in favor of Northwest Production Corporation. It is reasonable to presume that all of the non-standard unit is productive of gas.

According to our records, and as indicated on the attached plat, El Paso Natural Gas Company, Box 1492, El Paso, Texas, owns the mineral rights in Section 34 and Humble Oil and Refining Company, Box 1390, Midland, Texas, owns mineral rights in Section 35 which are located in Township 25 North, Range 4 West. Mr. R. R. Spurrier, Box 784, Santa Fe, New Mexico, owns mineral rights in the E/2 of Section 3, Township 24 North, Range 4 West, all of which offset our "S" Well 5-2. Copy of this request for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit is being given these operators by registered mail.

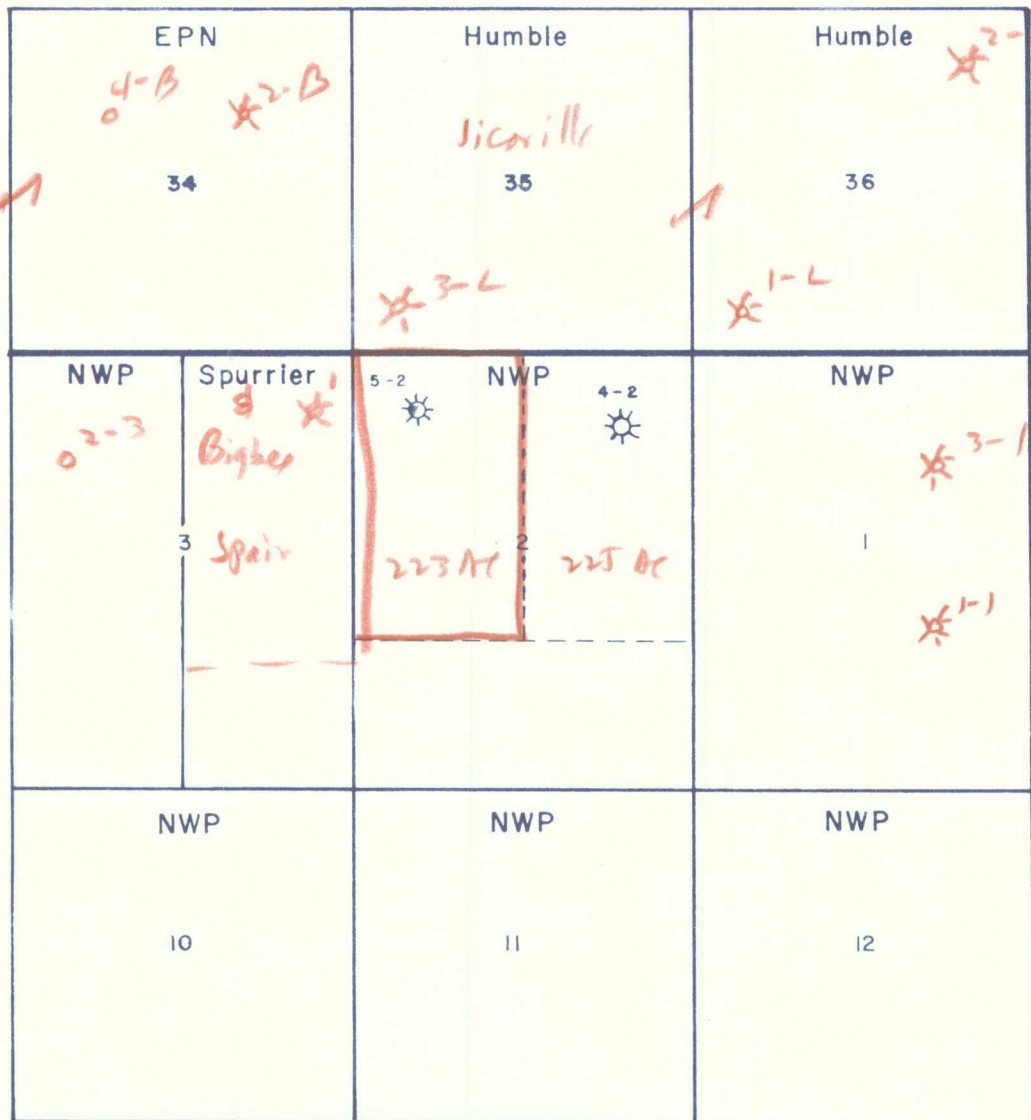

Dear Mr. Johnston:

This letter is in answer to your request for our waiver of right to a hearing before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for each of your two applications for approval of non-standard gas proration units occasioned by variations in the governmental survey.

El Paso Natural Gas Company has no objection to your request and gives waiver of hearing for:

- ✓ (1) Non-standard proration unit totaling 225 acres for your "S" Well 7-4 and consisting of the NW/4 of Section 4 including lots 3 and 4 contiguous to such NW/4, T24N, R4W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
- (2) Non-standard proration unit totaling 223 acres for your "S" Well 5-2 and consisting of the NW/4 of Section 2 including lots 3 and 4 contiguous to such NW/4, T24N, R4W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Said waiver is given with the understanding that:

- (1) Both Section 4 and Section 2, T24N and R4W are larger than the normal 640 acre section.
- (2) For the total acreage contained within said sections to be assigned to wells drilled therein, it will be necessary to obtain exceptions to the normal 160


