Due to erroneous survey the #3 McConnell well was originally located in the Southeast quarter of Section 31, which contains 160 acres. When the survey was corrected the location was shown to be in the Southwest quarter of the Section, which contains 178.93 acres. We did not note the change in acreage; therefore our records indicated that the #3 well was located in a standard quarter section and the #2 McConnell well was in a non-standard quarter section. After a further search of records we find that the #2 McConnell is in the Southeast quarter of Section 31-25N-3W. Such quarter contains 160 acres, being a standard quarter section. The #3 McConnell is located in the Southwest quarter of Section 31-25N-3W. This quarter section contains 178.93 acres. Apparently our mistake led you to request a non-standard proration unit on August 13, 1957 for the #2 McConnell. The request should have been for the #3 McConnell, located 1157 feet from the South line and 2200 feet from the West line of Section 31-25N-3W.
