Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of All or (Lots 3,4, S/2 NW/4, SW/4) of Section 5, Township 29 North, Range 8 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The Sunray #1 Well, located 990' from the South line and 990' from the West line of Section 5, Township 29 North, Range 8 West, was completed as a gas well from the Mesaverde Formation on April 9, 1953.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 324.74 acres, which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
