Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of the southwest quarter (SW/4) or (E/2 SW/4, Lots 3, 4) of Section 7, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Sunray #1-J Well, located 1090' from the South line and 990' from the West line of Section 7, T-30-N, R-10-W, was completed as a gas well from the Pictured Cliffs Formation on February 28, 1958.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 156.51 acres, which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.


Notice


