

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit consisting of the N/2 or (Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8) of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Cundiff #2-A Well, located 1714' from the North line and 956' from the East line of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, was completed as a gas well from the Mesaverde Formation on March 26, 1958.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 299.27 acres, which are contiguous lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.


Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of


