Mr. Morris Young,

Good morning.

My name is Leonard Lowe and I just received your renewal Discharge Plan application renewal for your Farmington facility, GW-221.

Question: was there a \$100 filing fee submitted along with this application? If not, one needs to be submitted. Checks need to be made payable to the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission.

Mr. Edward J. Hansen is no longer processing your permit. I will be processing it. I will consult with him on past history with your facility.

NOTE: The OCD has been challenged by industry on discharge permits. As a result of this the OCD has splintered discharge permits for all different operations (Compressor Stations, Gas Plants, Service Companies and Refineries). The OCD has compressor station permits update only thus far. The OCD will initiate as much work as possible on your submitted application renewal but will not meet the initial milestone (Administratively Complete Status) until the service facility permits jargon are updated. In the mean time you are currently operational on your current permit and have done what is required from the applicant to renew its permit. I may have some initial inquiries on your application when in initial review. I could not find an applicant version of your Public Notice within your application. Please submit that for review (in English and in Spanish). The Applicant shall only publish the OCD approved public notice. Failure to do so will result in the applicant to republish its public notice. Further direction in Notice will be noted at that time.

Eventually I would like to perform an inspection of your GW-221 facility.
