Dear Sir:

Request is respectfully made to you as Secretary-Director of the Commission to grant an exception to Rule 1A of Order No. R-1287, without notice and hearing, due to the variations in the legal sub-division of the United States Public Land Survey.

Skelly Oil Company's Farming "E" Well No. 3, located 1850' from the South line and 1750' from the West line of Section 2, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, has been dually completed as a Dakota gas and Gallup oil well.

In accordance with Order No. R-1287, we desire to dedicate acreage for the Dakota Zone as the W/2 of Section 2, but due to lots along the North line of Township 24 North in addition to the W/2 of Section 2, Lot 3, in the amount of 10.77 acres and Lot 4 in the amount of 10.66 acres in this oversized governmental Section 2, for a total of 341.33 acres as a non-standard unit. Attached hereto is a plat showing the names of the offset operators and also a certified surveyor's plat showing this information, which has heretofore been filed with the Oil Conservation Commission. You will notice that the non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections or lots lying wholly within a single governmental section and is completely surrounded by Dakota producing gas with the assignment of the W/2 of Section 2 in the amount of 341.33 acres as a non-standard unit, the length or width not exceeding 5,280 feet and by varification hereinafter affidavit that all of the offset operators were notified by registered mail of applicant's intent to form such non-standard unit.

Skelly Oil Company owns the entire acreage for Dakota in Section 2, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, and the offset operators and their addresses are as follows:
