




Gentlemen:

Gentlemen:

Pubco Petroleum Corporation hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) (or Lots 1,2,3, 4,5, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 6, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Federal #6-B (KD) Well, located 990 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, has heretofore been drilled and completed as a Dakota formation Gas Well and Application for Exception to rule 1(a) of Order R-1287 for a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit was made and subsequently approved by the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico.
2. The Federal #6-B (KD) Well is to re-entered and completed in the Mesaverde formation and will ultimately be productive from both the Mesaverde and Dakota formations.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas unit consists of 288.18 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas unit lies wholly within a single government section.
5. That the proposed non-standard gas unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
6. That the length and width of the proposed non-standard gas unit does not exceed 5280 feet.

7. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas unit.

Therefore, Pubco Petroleum Corporation requests that under the provisions of Rule 5(b) of Order R-1670, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 5 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.



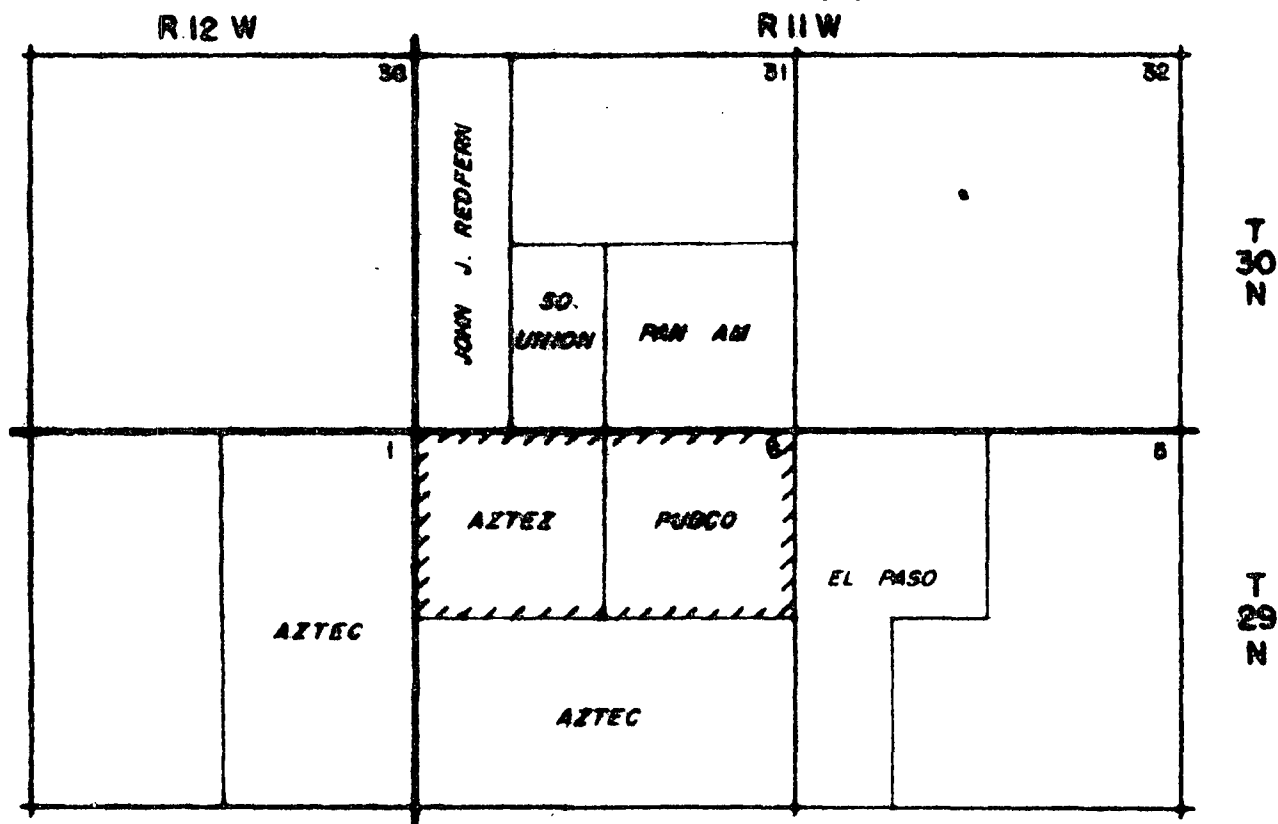
