Dear Mr. Bratton:

Reference is made to your application on behalf of Century Exploration Company for approval of a 327.29-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST, NMPM
Section 27: W/2

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to a well located 1190 feet from the North line and 790 feet from the West line (NW/4 NW/4) of said Section 27.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, Century Exploration Company is hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 327.29 acres.
