Gentlemen:

In accordance with Rule 5(B) of Order R-1670, El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of Lots 1,2, N/2 SW/4 (SW/4) of Section 36, Township 28 North, Range 8 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:


1. That the proposed non-standard proration unit consists of 156.15 acres which is less acreage than a standard proration unit.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That El Paso Natural Gas Company owns the Pictured Cliffs gas rights (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, and, therefore, notice to other operators is not necessary.

Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provisions of Rule 5(B) of Order R-1670, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 5(A) without Notice and Hearing and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.


