Skelly Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval of a non-standard unit for its Navajo "H" Well No. 1, located in Unit "A" of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. The nonstandard unit being requested in the NE/4 of said Section 13.

The Commission recently issued Order No. 3707 establishing 320-acre units for gas wells and 60-acre units for oil wells in this pool. Gas-oil ratio tests taken during April, 1969, indicate a gas-oil ratio in excess of 30,000 cubic feet per barrel of oil. Attached are copies of completed Form G-102 and a plat indicating ownership.

By carbon copy of this letter we are requesting the offset operators to furnish you a waiver of objection to the establishment of this nonstandard unit.

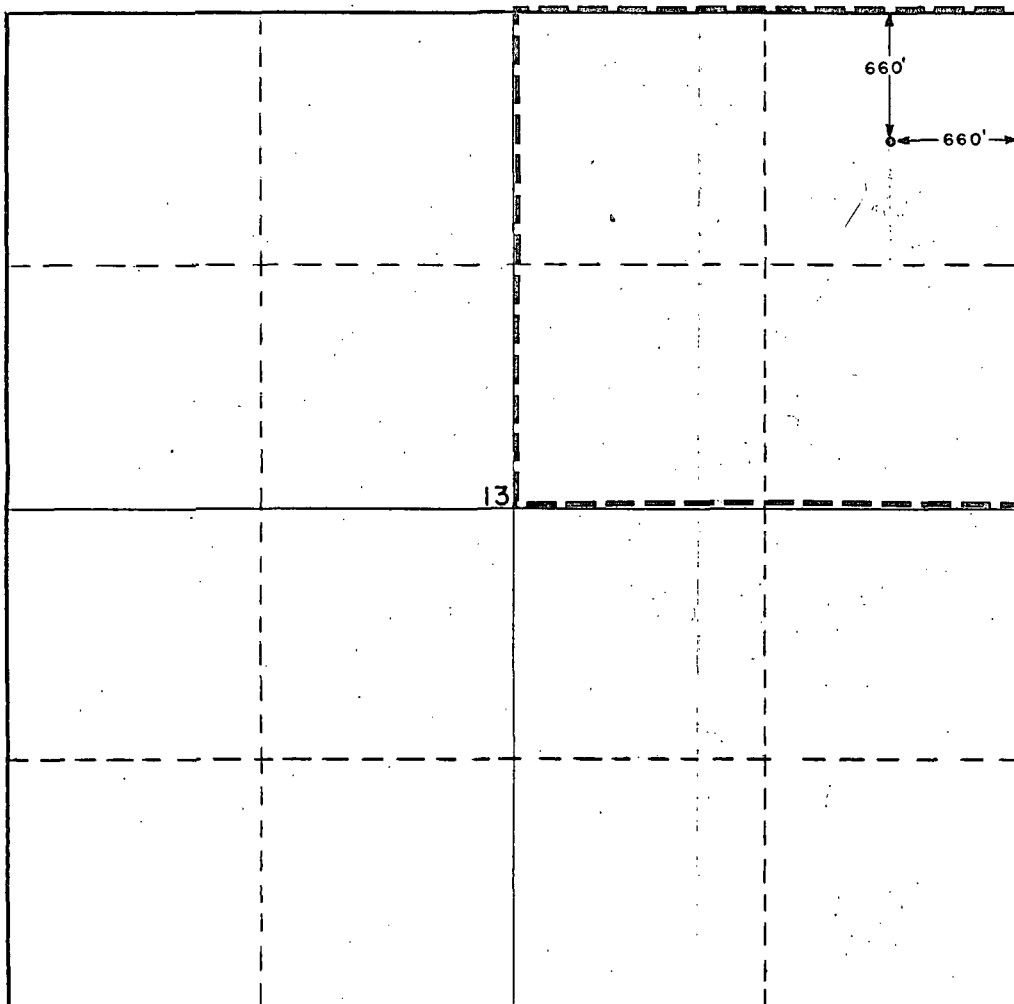

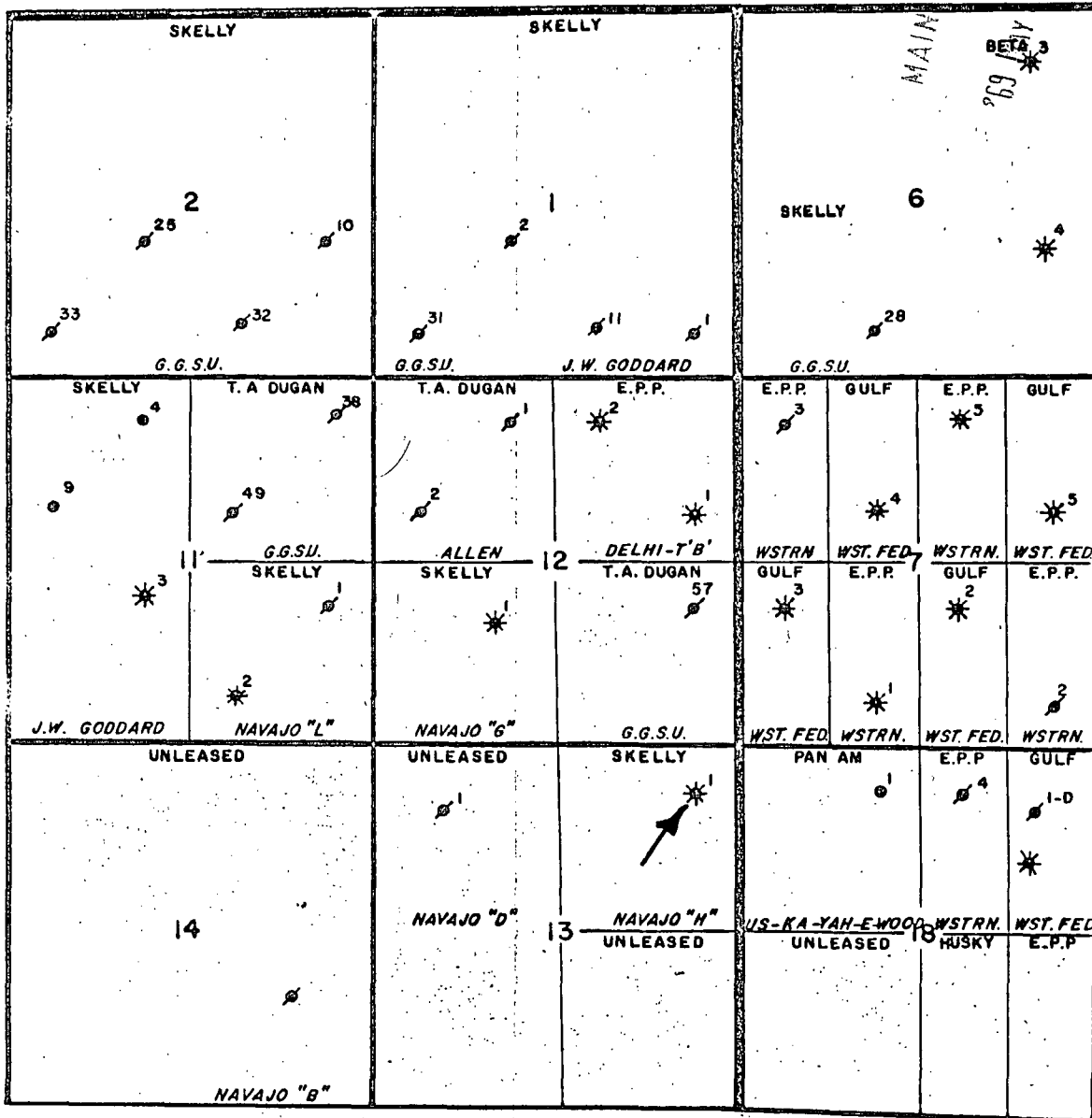
