Mr. Hansen:

Groundwater recovery efforts for EME Gaither boot (1R427-172) will be complete in approximately two weeks utilizing the recovery system at EME L-6. The recovery system located at EME K-6 is currently being utilized by EME B-8 (1R0480). Given the upcoming availability of the L-6 recovery system and the large chloride mass for EME B-8 (10,725 kg), ROC requests to utilize both recovery systems (EME L-6 and EME K-6) for EME B-8 chloride mass removal. NMOCD will be notified when pumping is complete for Gaither boot and recovery efforts for B-8 commence at the L-6 recovery system. 


