A hole in the water tank was the source of the release. The remaining fluid in the tank was transferred into another tank and a vacuum truck was called to pick up the standing fluid.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

An approximate size of 40' x 60' was impacted. The impacted area is located around between the water tanks and oil tanks. Soil from the pooling areas was excavated and disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will taken and analysis ran for TPH and BTEX once all contaminated material has been removed. Chlorides analysis upon request. **Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approx. 297', per New Mexico State Engineers Office); Wellhead Protection Area: No; Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000'; SITE RANKING IS 0. Based on site ground water quality and enclosed analytical results.**
