Dear Mr. Verquer:

Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to Rule 303.A. of the Division Rules and Regulations to permit the above-described well to commingle production from the subject pools in the well bore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to the provisions of Rule 303.C., and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such downhole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and any Division Order which authorized the dual completion and required separation of the zones is hereby placed in abeyance.

The maximum daily gas and oil produced from each pool in this well shall be determined using Division Rules and Regulations.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis **unless changed by permission of the Aztec district office of the Division and copied to this office.**

South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool	Oil 84%	Gas 60%
Basin-Dakota Prorated Gas Pool	Oil 16%	Gas 40%

REMARKS: The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon implementation of the commingling process.

Pursuant to Rule 303.H., the commingling authority granted herein may be rescinded by the Division Director if conservation is not being best served by such commingling.

This application to down hole commingle is hereby approved at Santa Fe, New Mexico on this 23rd day of February 2004.
