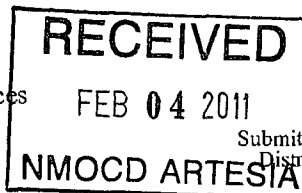




¼" nipple on circulating pump started leaking when the pump was turned on, due to worn out threads. The nipple and valves have been replaced and the circulating pump has been put back into service.					
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*					
Initially 24bbls was released from the circulating pump and we were able to recover 23bbls with a vacuum truck. All released oil was completely contained inside the dike walls of the facility. The facility will be scraped and the contaminated soil will be disposed of appropriately. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
