Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A fiberglass collar broke while working on a water tank. The collar has been replaced and the tank has been put back into service.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially we released 300bbbs of produced water from the water tank at the Aid State SWD facility. We were able to pick up 298bbbs of produced water with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the dike walls of the facility, which is lined with a 40 mil liner. All of the contaminated gravel will be removed and replaced with clean gravel. We will follow up with a C-141 Final Report.

On 6-28-10 at 5:00pm, a fiberglass collar broke while working on a tank at the Aid St. SWD. 300bbls of produced water was released into the dike which is lined with 40mil plastic. We were able to recover 298bbls. The collar will be replaced and the tank placed back in service. All contaminated gravel inside the dike will be removed and then replaced with clean gravel.
