

Filter pot and alarm transducer froze. Thawed out the filter pot and replaced filters; repaired alarm transducer.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 20bbls was released from the water tank and we were able to recover 19bbls of fluid. The spill was completely contained on the location and the released fluid traveled the same path as previous spill. All fluid has been picked up, pad location has been scraped of contaminates. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will submit a remediation work plan for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
