An approximate area of 10' X 70', all on well pad. Vacuum truck called to pick up remaining oil, impacted soils to be scraped up and taken to an NMOCD approved facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and analysis ran for TPH & BTEX. If initial analytical results for TPH & BTEX are under RRAL's a Final Report, C-141 will be submitted to the OCD requesting closure. **Depth to Ground Water: 50-99' (approximately 70', Section 27-T16S-R27E, per NMOSE), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 10. Based on recovered amounts of oil, impacted soils excavated/hailed and enclosed analytical results, Yates Petroleum Corporation requests closure.**
