Amanda,

As stated in the OCD letter dated August 9, 2010, a corrective action work plan proposal (plan) is to be formulated based on vertical and horizontal delineation of contaminants. The only analytical data OCD has been provided with to date, shows a sampling date of 4/27/10. The receiving date at the lab for these samples was listed as 6/10/10. This is well beyond the hold time for hydrocarbon analysis and, as a result, this analytical data is not acceptable. Even based on this data, the site has not been delineated.

Your memorandum indicates that additional material was excavated and samples were obtained on July 27, 2010. OCD does not have the results of this sampling event. Please review the August 9 request letter and provide a plan based on a complete delineation of the site. Also, as requested, when submitting analytical data, please provide a detailed diagram showing where samples were obtained.

This plan, as submitted does not meet the requested requirements and is not approved by OCD.

I'm sorry, I believe I misunderstood your email and confused the issue. Please allow me to clarify. YPC has continued to excavate the location to meet the recommended actions levels set by OCD guidelines. All samples taken at this location have been for the purpose of vertical and horizontal delineation of contamination. The samples ran in June were to verify the samples I had run in our lab. These samples were never meant for official use but as a quality control for our lab. The samples were only produced by request of and for visual explanation for the land owner. None of the samples taken up from this location are for official use. At the time of final closure YPC will request a witnessed sampling. YPC is continuing to excavate material and sample along the way to ensure recommended action levels are met. Attached is a new work plan and visual diagram of sampled area.
