Dear Mr. Sanchez:

On behalf of Nearburg Producing Company ("Nearburg") and pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.15.13 and the applicable rules governing oil well locations for the South Humble City-Strawn Pool (33500; Order No. R-6913, as amended), we request administrative approval for an unorthodox well location for the Honey 13 Well No. 1 at the surface and bottom-hole locations reflected above.

This well will be drilled to a depth sufficient to test the Strawn formation within the boundaries of the South Humble City-Strawn Oil Pool. The rules for the pool currently provide that wells shall be located within 150 feet of the center of a governmental quarter-quarter section or lot, with 80-acre units dedicated to the wells. The C-101 along with the C-102 plat showing the W/2 NE/4 spacing unit and the proposed unorthodox location for the Honey 13 Well No. 1 are attached as Exhibit A.

Nearburg seeks an exception from the applicable well location rules for the well for the following reasons: (1) The surface is utilized as irrigated crop land and at a standard location under the pool rules, the well would interfere with a pivot-point

irrigation system. The irrigation system and proposed location are demonstrated on the enclosed aerial photo (Exhibit "B"); (2) The well will be drilled from a pre-existing rig pad that was constructed but not utilized. The use of the pre-existing pad will avoid the need to disturb additional surface; (3) Based on development in the adjoining units and on Nearburg's interpretation of geologic and geophysical data, the well would be optimally situated to encounter and produce from an isolated algal mound typical of Strawn formation reservoirs in the area. (See attached affidavit, Exhibit "C").


There is presently no Strawn formation well or dedicated spacing unit in the offsetting 80-acre spacing unit toward which the proposed location encroaches in the E/2 NW/4 of Section 13 T17S R37E. Nearburg owns 69.79180% of the leasehold working interest in the adjoining spacing unit, Chesapeake owns approximately 2.08125% and the remaining interests are unleased. Nearburg is providing notification to and obtaining waivers of objections from the other working interest owner and the owners of the unleased mineral interests. (See notice list, Exhibit "D").







AFFIDAVIT

1. My name is Bill Elton. I am a geologist for Nearburg Producing Company in the company's Midland, Texas office. I am familiar with the subject matter of this Application and am otherwise competent to testify to the matters set forth herein.
2. Nearburg Producing Company seeks approval of an unorthodox well location as follows:
 Honey 13 Well No. 1
 API No. 30-025-40083
 280' FNL and 2450' FEL (B) (Surface)
 723' FNL and 2149' FEL (B) (Bottom hole)
 Section 13 , T17S, R37E Lea County, New Mexico
3. This well will be drilled to the Strawn formation. The applicable pool rules for the South Humble City-Strawn pool in this area provide that wells must be located within 150 feet of the center of a quarter-quarter section.
4. I have examined and geologic and geophysical data of the Strawn formation in the NE/4 of Section 13. The Strawn formation production in the area is typically from isolated algal mounds that are of limited areal extent. Based on my interpretation of the available data, I have concluded that a well drilled to the proposed bottom hole location will be better situated to more completely and efficiently recover Strawn formation reserves than would be likely if the well were drilled at a standard location. Further, because of the limited size of the isolated Strawn formation mound being targeted, the correlative rights of owners in the adjacent section are not likely to be impaired.
