Cliff,

Based on the analytical data provided, your proposal to remove 3'-5' of impacted material is approved with the following conditions/stipulations:

- Notify OCD 48 hours prior to commencement of remedial activities.
- Notify OCD 48 hours prior to obtaining samples where analyses will be submitted to OCD.
- Notify OCD upon reaching the proposed excavation depth, or the maximum depth as is practicable due to rock.
- Remedial requirements may be subject to modification as site conditions may warrant.
- Submit a closure report and a Form C-141 Final Report upon satisfactory completion of project.
- Like approval by BLM as may be applicable.

It is OCD's understanding that ground water was not encountered during soil boring operations.

Be advised, OCD approval does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that may pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and/or regulations.
