Permission is hereby granted to commingle oil produced from wells located on State Lease B-9311, Mexico "J" lease at a location of 660' from the south line and 300' from the east line of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This lease is a 320 acre tract confined by the S/2 of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 38 East adjoining with State Lease B-9312, Mexico "L" lease which is also a 320 acre tract confined by the N/2 of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 38 East.

This acreage in both leases will be credited to Common Schools. When reporting production on our Production and Royalty Statements Form SLO-111-A please combine production on the SLO showing both lease numbers.

Skelly Oil Company is now in the process of drilling a well in the Dollarhide Devonian Pool on its Mexico "J" lease at a location of 660' from the south line and 330' from the east line of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This lease is a 320 acre tract confined by the S/2 Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 38 East. Upon completion of this well, it is our plan to connect this well into the present existing Devonian tank battery on our adjoining Mexico "U" lease which is also a 320 acre tract confined by the N/2 Section 5, Township 26 South, Range 38 East.

In support of this application for administrative approval for an exception to Statewide Rule No. 309, we wish to make the following statements:

1. That the above two tracts concern but a single royalty owner, namely, the State of New Mexico, and are both dedicated to a common beneficiary.
2. That the above two tracts are contiguous.
3. That a plat of this general area showing offset ownership, present Devonian wells, present tank battery and flow lines and proposed flow lines, has been prepared and is accurate and complete to the best of our knowledge.
4. That all offset operators have been notified by Registered Mail with a copy of this application.

Therefore, so that undue hardship will not be enforced, Skelly Oil Company requests that the Secretary of the Commission administratively grant an exception to Statewide Rule 309, by which oil from separate State leases may be produced into a common tank battery.
