Dear Mr. Porter:

We are currently developing two leases on the east edge of the Eumont Field, both located in Section 36, T-19-S, R-37-E, NMPM, Lea County. The development program includes one well now producing on the 40-acre State EMA lease (Shell NM-519A; New Mexico State B-1167), and two wells under completion on the 200-acre State EMB lease (Shell NM-1549; New Mexico State E-5674). Three additional wells will be drilled on this latter lease contingent upon the successful completion of the first three wells. The lease holdings, prospective well locations, and tank battery location are shown on the attached plat.

We propose to centralize oil treating and storage facilities for the above wells, and to locate this unitized battery on the State EMB lease at the location shown on the plat. This commingling of leases will afford a substantial saving (\$8000) in initial investment cost, plus considerable savings in operational expense over the life of the centralized battery facilities; as compared to separate tank batteries for each lease. The proposed central tank battery will include adequate tankage and other equipment for accurate determination of production from each lease.

We have obtained permission to this centralized tank battery proposal from the Office of the Commissioner of Public Lands. The offset operators to these two Shell leases have been notified of our proposal and waivers were sent to each of these operators to waive notice and hearing under Rule 309b, as revised by Order R-645, as to this application for commingling into the centralized tank battery.

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We have received answers with waivers, from eight of the twelve offset operators; however, we have not received correspondence from the remaining four operators. The specified 30-day waiting period is now over, and we are, therefore, forwarding the eight waivers with this letter, along with certified mail receipts for the waiver request letters, which were sent to all offset operators.


Temporary approval to produce the State EMA lease production into a tank battery located on the State EMB lease, has been granted by Mr. R.L. Montgomery of the Hobbs, New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Office. This temporary approval, however, did not include commingling of production from the two leases.

With the preliminary work for this application now completed, we are hereby making formal application for administrative approval for commingling in a common tank battery, the oil production from our State EMA and State EMB leases in the Eumont Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

Your letter of March 19, 1957 requested permission to transport oil from the State EMA Well No. 1-M, 36-19-37, Eumont Pool to a tank battery located on the State EMB lease in the same section, both leases being contiguous. This request would be an exception to Rule 309 (a).

This office has on file a letter of approval from the Commissioner of Public Lands. Further, the circumstances in this case comply with all of the requirements for administrative approval except the consent of all adjoining owners which, I am informed, is being obtained at the present time.

In view of the above facts temporary permission to transport oil from the State EMA lease to the State EMB lease for storage is hereby granted pending final disposition by the Director, Mr. A. L. Porter. However, this writer has no authority to grant commingling of oil from different leases, therefore no production from the State EMB lease shall be commingled with the State EMA lease until approved by the Director.


