Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for administrative approval for exception to Rule 309 (a) in the Loco Hills Pool.

It is understood that the exception to Rule 309 (a) is to be ascribed to your State "0" lease known as State Lease No. B-6058-20 and has Well No. 1 completed on it, which is a 40 acre lease described as the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 2, and your State lease known as State Lease No. B-6570-16 and has Well No. 2-A completed on it, which is a 40 acre lease described as the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 2, both leases are in Township 18 South, Range 29 East, Loco-Hills Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 309, Section (b) - 4 and 5, of the New Mexico Statewide Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to operate a central tank battery on the above described acreage as an exception to Rule 309 (a).
