Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated September 16, 1957, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309 (a) in the West Lovington Pool.

It is understood that this exception to Rule 309 (a) is to be ascribed to your State "Q" Lease, also known as State Lease No. B-4704 comprising the NE/4 Section 8, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico and to your State "P" Lease, also known as State Lease No. B-7016, comprising the NW/4, NW/4 NE/4, and the SE/4 NE/4 Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 309, Section (b)-6 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to operate a central tank battery on the above described acreage as an exception to Rule 309 (a). This approval is granted for a maximum of eight wells to be produced into this central tank battery.
