

Gentlemen:

This letter is to request that Humble Oil & Refining Company be granted administrative approval for an exception to Rule 309(a) in order that we might commingle the production from our New Mexico State "P" Lease and New Mexico State "Q" Lease in the West Lovington Field. We previously requested approval from Mr. Murray E. Morgan, Commissioner of Public Lands, for his approval to combine the production from the above mentioned leases. This approval was granted on September 12, 1957, a copy of which is attached.

Commingle of the production from these two leases is requested since the daily water production from our New Mexico State "Q" Lease has increased to a point where installation of a flow treater will be required to economically treat the oil. Our New Mexico State "P" Lease now has treating facilities that could handle the water production from both leases, and by extending three flow lines we could commingle the production from these leases thereby eliminating the installation of additional treating facilities. At the present time there are three producing wells on our New Mexico State "P" Lease with an allowable of 35 barrels per day, and three producing wells on our New Mexico State "Q" Lease with an allowable of 35 barrels per day.

The following is a description of the subject leases:

New Mexico State "Q" Lease, State Lease No. B-4704, Humble Lease No. 76324, NE/4 of Sec. 8, T-17-S, R-36-E, Lea County New Mexico.

New Mexico State "P" Lease, State Lease No. B-7016, Humble Lease No. 65795, NW/4, NW/4 of the NE/4 and the SE/4 of the NE/4 of Sec. 9, T-17-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of the above requested exception we would like to point out the following:

- ✓ 1. The separate leases are dedicated to one beneficiary institution, common schools.

- ✓ 2. All six wells are producing from one reservoir.
- ✓ 3. No more than eight wells will be produced into a common tank battery, and that adequate testing facilities will be provided for individual well testing.
- ✓ 4. All offset operators have been notified of this application by Certified Mail.
- ✓ 5. A letter from the State Land Commissioner approving commingling of oil from these two leases.

We have attached a plat showing the present tank batteries and individual flow lines and the proposed changes after consolidation. Your early consideration of this matter will be appreciated.
