Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated October 17, 1957, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 309 (a) in the Pearl Queen Pool.

It is understood that this exception to Rule 309 (a) is to be ascribed to your State "PA" Lease, also known as New Mexico State Lease E-5838, comprising the E/2 SW/4 of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 35 East and to your State "PB" Lease also known as New Mexico State E-5839, comprising the E/2 NW/4 of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as a waiver of objection has been received from Cabot Carbon Company, it is possible for immediate approval of this request for an exception to Rule 309 to be given.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 309, Section (b)-6 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to operate a central tank battery on the above described acreage in exception to Rule 309 (a).
